Based on an investigation on the Presidential Advisory Council on the government of Michelle Bachelet, is developed here a theoretical framework on social movements and the so called subpolitical ways, that allows to see how the student's movement of 2006 challenged the secondary level educational enclave, and the kind of response a government that was seeking for a citizen's seal gave through the formation of an Advisory Council with the participation of various sectors.
