Delia Graff Fara died in July 2017 at the age of 48. In spite of her youth, Delia was an extremely influential philosopher. *Theoria* wishes to celebrate her life and her career by publishing three essays that engage critically Delia's ideas on two issues on which she produced seminal work: the treatment of vagueness and the predicativist approach to the semantics of proper names.

GENOVEVA MARTÍ is ICREA Research Professor in Philosophy at the University of Barcelona. She obtained her PhD at Stanford University. She has been faculty at the University of Washington (Seattle), the University of California (Riverside), the London School of Economics and the University of Western Ontario. She is Chair of the Philosophy, Theology and Religious Studies Section of the *Academia Europaea*.
