Abstract

This study analyzes Hans Jonas's critique of utopianism and compares his proposal for a responsible élite with the Platonic proposal for a polis ruled by guardian-philosophers, to show the biased character of his concept of responsibility. In contrast, a plural concept of responsibility is offered, inspired by the converging ethics of Ricardo Maliandi.
