JB I Comprehensive Systematic Review Training Program (CS RTP) in Coimbra, Portugal

The Portugal Centre for Evidence Based Practice (PCEBP) organized the 3rd Comprehensive Systematic Review Training Program (CS RTP). It took place from May 30th to June 3rd 2016 at the Health Sciences Research Unit: Nursing (UICISA: E), Nursing School of Coimbra.

5th Congress on Nursing Research of Ibero-American and Portuguese-speaking Countries with an International Evidence Based Health Care Symposium

UICISA: E, hosted by the Nursing School of Coimbra, held its biennial scientific event in June 2016 - the 5th Congress on Nursing Research of Ibero-American and Portuguese-speaking Countries (June 7th and 8th). This year, the event was enriched by the integration of the International Evidence Based Health Care Symposium (June 6th).

The 5th Congress on Nursing Research fits into the UICISA: E strategic axis for the international dissemination of relevant and valid scientific production for healthcare professionals' training and healthcare improvement. Considering the importance and relevance of the study and implementation of Evidence-based Action, we added that Symposium in order to share experiences and results of synthesis science, implementation, care effectiveness, and innovation.

International Evidence Based Health Care Symposium was a success. The organization received 308 participants. Besides abstracts presentations, the Symposium program consisted of one conference and two panels.

Professor Bridie Kent was the keynote speaker of the conference on “Evidence based Practice and Health Gains”, which was coordinated by Professor Manuel Alves Rodrigues.



The speakers of panel I, entitled “Production of knowledge to Evidence based Practice (production, synthesis, implementation and best practices)”, which was coordinated by Professor Aida Mendes, were: Professor Inge Madsen, Professor João Costa and Professor João Apóstolo.



The speakers of panel II, entitled “Healthcare Technology Innovation”, which was coordinated by Professor Pedro Parreira, were: business partners Daniel Fonseca and Bruno Silva, and Professor Beatriz Guitton.

All speakers’ presentations were on current and relevant issues.



Considering the success and utility of the International Evidence Based Health Care Symposium in the context of Evidence Based Practice, we will continue to promote it as part of the UICISA: E biennial scientific event.
